The Brahma Kumaris is a global network of organisations with 8,500 established centres in over 130 countries and 900,000 regular students; many of whom go on to become meditation teachers and presenters.

The BKs offer a wide variety of programs, workshops and retreats on the spiritual dimension of personal development, community building and the well-being of our planet. The organisation is also invited to participate in conferences and dialogues, e.g. climate change. At the core of Brahma Kumaris teachings is BK Raja Yoga meditation and philosophy.

The spiritual headquarters, based in Mt Abu, Rajasthan India, is affiliated with the UN; having general category consultative status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC), in consultative status with UNICEF and is affiliated to the Department of Public Information (DPI).

The Brahma Kumaris have had a presence in Australia since 1975 and there are centres in most major cities, as well as three Retreat Centres. The BKs in Australia are registered as a charity in the area of education (spiritual). All programs are free of charge, as a service to the community and the organisation is run through the donations received by the public and its students.
